### 2014

Pitts Enterprises rewards employees with stock ownership plan, giving the employees a personal investment in the company.

### 2018

Pitts Enterprises significant expansion to the Pittsview, AL production facility. The project adds 25,000 square feet to Pitts Enterprises' existing 1,000,000+- square foot commercial trailer production plant.
